2. I will not try to enter files or systems that are restricted.
3. I will understand that, if others are waiting, I should be ready to stop when my time is up.
4. I will not try to enter my own programs onto the library’s computers.
5. I will tell my parents or library staff right away if I find something that scares me or if I have problems with the computer.

I understand that breaking these rules mean I will lose Internet privileges for 1 (one) year.
